PODS TO RIEWOLDT A WINNER

It was the most obvious trade of last round, moving on cult hero James Podsiadly for the improving Nick Riewoldt, who wasn't going to get much cheaper than \$340,000. Almost 11,000 coaches made the transition, which was clearly the most popular trade for the round, behind trading down for mature age recruit Kyle Hardingham. In hindsight though, going for Lion youngster Ryan Harwood may have been the better option, considering he scored 42 more points than Hardingham. Upgrading to premiums was also a popular choice, with Dane Swan, Gary Ablett and Paul Chapman all making their way into our teams.

As mentioned above, James Podsiadly was the most traded out player last round, with 10,647 coaches giving him the boot. The biggest surprise though was the dropping of Jimmy Bartel, with over 3,000 coaches trading him out despite only missing the one game. That could prove to be a trade that haunts you in weeks to come.

If you have Dane Swan in your side, it's pretty hard to overlook him for your captain this week. Almost two thirds of the competition is without the ball-magnet though, which means that you have to think long and hard as to whom you give the captain's arm band to this week.

After a downer against Adelaide in Round 16, Gary Ablett has to be considered. He's bounced back over the past two weeks, with 126 and 127 points respectively, while booting a combined eight goals. He loves playing against the Magpies and has topped to the 100 point mark in each of his past five games against them, averaging 117 points per match. Matthew Boyd is in career best form and is another option, but his record at AAMI Stadium isn't that great, averaging 65 points per game across his career, with only two scores over 90 points. If you're looking at catching your opponent off guard, then Colin Sylvia looms as a good smoky. He's coming off a season-high 149 points against Brisbane and racked up 125 points against the Tigers when he last came up against them in Round 4. He's also playing his 100th AFL match this week, which could spur him on for another big game.
