SANDILANDS DILEMMA

With Fremantle facing one of the longest road trips in Australian sport, I would be staggered if they took Aaron Sandilands to Aurora Stadium this week. So the question remains, do we trade him out? Or do we cover him with an active emergency if we have one?

If you have either one of Robert Warnock or Jackson Trengove as cover, then you can probably get away with holding onto him in the hope that he returns for the final H&A game of the season against Carlton. In saying that though, can either of these two players be trusted in a big final? Yes, they have provided great cover over the past two weeks, but I wouldn't be confident in either player pulling out another big score this week.

If you opt to trade, then Hamish McIntosh has been the form ruckman of the competition over the past month, averaging 99 points per match, with three scores over 90 points in successive weeks. He travels to Subiaco this week, a venue he has averaged only 62 points at in his past five games, but he does finish the year off with a game against Melbourne, having two 100 plus scores from his past three games against them under his belt. Shane Mumford and Darren Jolly are two other good options, but I would advise you to stay well clear of Dean Cox, with the Eagles finishing the year off with a trip to Skilled Stadium.

ROUND 21 CAPTAINS

Like last week, you should look at picking a captain from St Kilda this round, as they come up against the lowly Richmond. I gave you the Nick Riewoldt tip last week and he didn't disappoint with seven goals and 142 points against North Melbourne. His recent record against Richmond isn't as good, but that shouldn't deter you in any way. You can pick him with plenty of confidence again this week.

If you're after a safer bet though, then you can't go past Brendon Goddard. He has cracked the ton in all but one game since Round 6 and has averaged 116 points per match in this period, which is the fourth-best record of any player in the league. He has good form against the Tigers already this season also, scoring a season-high 138 points when these sides last met in Round 11.

One player that doesn't feature below is Luke Hodge. He's been tagged quite heavily over the past three weeks, averaging only 70 points per game, but despite his poor recent form, he should seriously be considered. The Hawks take on the struggling Dockers at Aurora Stadium this week, a venue he has already returned scores of 110, 140 and 126 points already this year from his three games.

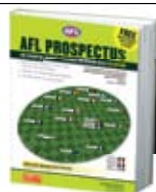

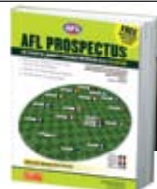
