Take note of which players played last week, as most clubs fielded stronger teams, which will give you a better guide when making your final decisions. Good luck to all coaches for Round 1 and I hope that you all register a first up win.

SUNS STARTING LINE UP?

With Gold Coast not playing its first match until Round 2, there may be some conjecture about the final makeup of its side. Below I have included my starting 22, with a number of positions still up in the air mainly due to injury. We haven't seen Smith all pre-season and I would doubt that Guy McKenna will risk a young ruckman without any match practice, so this could see Gorringe replace him in the starting line up. Ablett and Brennan are two other players' that haven't featured, but I expect both to play against the Blues. Iles is one player that I had locked in the starting line up for some time, but he has only made one appearance, which has clouded his involvement in the season opener.

One player that won't feature against Carlton is Magin who is still rookie listed. The Suns can't promote a player to the senior list before the Round 1, so unless they have a long-term injury he remains out of the picture.



Carlton was able to upgrade up to two rookies before Round 1 and Curnow has won the first spot. He has played in all three NAB Challenge games and averaged a respectable 59 points per match. As a basement price rookie he could be a handy pick up for your midfield, provided he plays in Round 1.

He's been a key figure in the Dockers midfield this pre-season averaging 90 points per match, so make sure you pick him.
