Hi and welcome to the first H&A edition of the Fantasy Freako's rave for 2011. In what was an action packed opening round, the new substitute and concussion rules caused us plenty of debate, with both Foley and Selwood returning dismal scores as a result. It's no point complaining though, both rules are here to stay.

If you happened to lose your opening fixture there is no need to panic, especially by pulling the trigger with an early trade. Unless you have a long-term injury, you should avoid trading completely this week. Enjoy the read and good luck to all coaches for Round 2.

RUCKMEN ARE THE BIG WINNERS

Very few teams will take two conventional ruckman into games this season, which makes nailing your ruckman crucial. Only Carlton, Richmond and Essendon took two genuine ruckman into Round 1, with the Swans naming Mark Seaby as the substitute. The Bombers look to be the big winners from the new substitute rule, as they have the services of Hille and Ryder – two players that are as capable in attack as they are in the ruck.

Ruckman will be the main beneficiaries of the change this year, as they are likely to spend more time on the ground than ever before. If we look at the minutes played from the leading ruckman of last year that played in the opening round, only one of them recorded less time on the ground, this being Aaron Sandilands. Ben McEvoy had the biggest increase in game time, playing 87% of the game against the Cats – up from his 2010 average of 60% per match.

Nick Lower was next best with 98 points and Cameron Pedersen also looked lively with 97 against the Eagles.
